North Windham Fire Department is located on Route 6 (603 Boston Post Rd) in North Windham, Connecticut. Windham is a town in Windham County, Connecticut. It contains the city of Willimantic and the villages of Windham Center, North Windham, and South Windham. We cover the section of North Windham, in the town of Windham, and provide mutual aid to surrounding towns. We respond to fires, medical emergencies, motor vehicle accidents and a variety of other emergency calls. We are first responders, most of our department is EMS certified.

We respond with six apparatus, Engine Tank 102, Engine 102, Rescue 102, Service 102, Service 202 and Gator 102. Our rescue truck has a Hurst tool, including cutters, spreaders, rams and air bags. The three Windham Fire Departments share a Technical Rescue trailer.

We are always looking for volunteers to join the department. Dedicated people who live in our community, who are willing to donate their time and energy to the department.
